B1051 – Station Road, Overton – Drainage Cleansing & Works

As part of the annual Planned Maintenance programme, this letter is to let you know that we will be undertaking drainage cleansing and drainage works on Station Road, Overton.

These works are currently programmed to start as follows:

- Drainage cleansing works between 22 Station Road and the overbridge at Quidhampton Mill, from Wednesday 17th July 2024 which are expected to take up to 3 days to complete.
- Drainage works between Lambs Close and the overbridge at Quidhampton Mill, from Monday 22nd July 2024 which are expected to take up to 4 weeks to complete.

During these times the road will be closed to vehicular traffic between the hours of 09:30 – 16:00hrs, Monday – Friday working. Local access will be maintained for businesses and residents where possible and the road will be open outside of these hours and at weekends. Please note the planned diversion route is not suitable for Heavy Goods Vehicles (HGV) and therefore <u>all HGV movements must be</u> planned outside of working hours.

Whilst there is an allowance within the time periods shown above for delays, there may be times when the works are postponed at short notice; based on the latest weather forecasts, this can occur just prior to works commencing.
