



Cancer Diagnosis Audit

This GP practice is taking part in an important local project to improve how people are diagnosed with cancer.

If you were diagnosed with lung, pancreatic or oesophageal cancer between April 2023 and March 2024, your GP practice may share information about your diagnosis with Wessex Cancer Alliance, securely and anonymously.

This information might include symptoms you experienced, how many times you came in to see the GP with symptoms, what types of tests you had, and when you were referred.

All identifiable information (e.g. your name and date of birth) will be removed before sharing.

By being part of this audit, your GP practice is showing it is committed to diagnosing cancer as early as possible and to improving care for people with signs and symptoms that could be cancer.



Note: If you have previously requested for your information not to be used in this way, via the National opt-out policy, then we can assure you that your information will not be used for this audit.
